By being open about your relationship with Jesus and sharing with them the good news of the Gospel.




CONNECT THEM WITH THE BIBLE

To help them grow in their new-found faith.



WHO ARE YOUR "ALL"?

Everybody knows people who don't know Jesus yet.

LOOK AROUND YOU

You are with people every day – at work, in school, online, on the phone, having fun with friends and family. What would it look like if **every person** around you were prayed for by name and connected with regularly?

STEP OUTSIDE YOUR DOOR

Now, have a look up and down the street/ corridor/stairs – you can begin to reach people by starting right where you live, work, and play.

TOGETHER FOR ALL

You don't need to do it alone. Encourage your family and friends to pray for and connect with the people around them. If we do this together, we can reach All.

EVERY CHRISTIAN?

Wouldn't it be great if all of God's people were to rise to the challenge to adopt and pray for their friends, family and neighbors?

Even if just 1 of 3 evangelical/born-again
Christians would adopt 10 households, every
person in America would be covered multiple times.

MY "ALL"

Every believer has a role in finishing the Great Commission that Jesus gave us. **PRAY+CONNECT** is about strategically and practically doing your part in this urgent hour.

This small group guide is designed to help you pray for and connect with the people around you. Begin by identifying at least six individuals in your sphere that you will commit to reach over the next six weeks.

Using the **All.America app**, create a group where you can pray for and track your connections together.



STATS


Tracked in real-time.

EASY-TO-USE APP

The app is a simple tool to enable us to finish the task together.

FIRST

Download the free app or use the web version.

Locate your home address.

Adopt households near you and create groups with the names of friends and family members. (They will not see who adopted them.)

EVERY DAY

Make it a habit to pray through the list daily and keep track by clicking "I prayed" every time - the app can remind you to pray.

Do the same as you connect with them and see all of America working together in real-time.

As you get to know your neighbors, you can add their names and notes.

(Only you can see that info, it is not shared.)

MORE

Of course you can also add custom groups to pray for your family and friends who don't live nearby and invite others to pray with you.

We continue to add new features, like adopting schools, dashboards for local groups and churches... to make you even more effective in praying for every person in your community by name and reaching them for Jesus.

SESSION 1: WHY ALL?

INTRODUCTION

After his resurrection, Jesus appeared to his disciples over the course of forty days to convince them he was indeed alive and to speak about the kingdom of God. His last appearance was on a mountain in Galilee. It is there that Jesus gave his disciples, both present and future, the honor of participating with him in a mission so far-reaching and all-encompassing that it would only be possible with his power and presence.

SESSION 2: BEGIN WITH PRAYER

INTRODUCTION

Paul instructs Timothy, a leader in the Church, to teach believers to pray for everyone, even for kings and those in authority. As they put prayer first, they had the privilege of participating in God's work. Because they were the children of God, they could ask God for anything. But the greatest prayer they were to offer for all people was for their salvation. This pleases God because he desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

The crowds who followed him were like sheep without a shepherd to take care of them. When Jesus saw them, he felt compassion. He fed the hungry, healed the sick, raised the dead, and delivered those who were bound.
