

By being open about your relationship with Jesus and sharing with them the good news of the Gospel.




### **CONNECT THEM WITH THE BIBLE**

# WHO ARE YOUR "ALL"?

Everybody knows people who don't know Jesus yet.

# LOOK AROUND YOU

You are with people every day – at work, in school, online, on the phone, having fun with friends and family. What would it look like if **every person** around you were prayed for by name and connected with regularly?

# STEP OUTSIDE YOUR DOOR

Now, have a look up and down the street/ corridor/stairs - you can begin to reach people by starting right where you live, work and play.

# **TOGETHER FOR ALL**

You don't need to do it alone. Encourage your family and friends to pray for and connect with the people around them. If we do this together, we can reach All.

# SESSION 6: WELCOME TO THE FAMILY

# INTRODUCTION

The early Church was a community characterized by its devotion. All the believers were of one mind; committing themselves to God's Word, remembering Christ's sacrifice, prayer, and caring for one another's needs. Through Christ, believers from different economic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds became a family that loved one another deeply. As they submitted themselves to unity and humility, God moved powerfully in their midst.

But anyone who did not do what he said would experience a great loss.

Sometimes they did not know where they were going to preach until it was revealed to them. The Holy Spirit, who empowered them to be witnesses, also helped them know where to witness and went ahead of them to prepare the way.

# INTRODUCTION

As Jesus traveled throughout the villages, the spiritual and physical needs of the people were constantly before him. The crowds who followed him were like sheep without a shepherd to take care of them. When Jesus saw them, he felt compassion. He fed the hungry, healed the sick, raised the dead, and delivered those who were bound.
